WEATHER RELATED CANCELLATIONS AND DELAYS

Hilltop follows the Torrington Schools when bad weather comes to Connecticut. If Torrington Schools has a **delay**, Hilltop opens at 10:30 a.m. and dismisses at noon.

To accommodate the bus schedules when there is a **delay**, the **School Readiness Class** will follow the same delay schedule as Torrington Public schools, usually a **2 hour** delay.

When Torrington Schools are closed, we will be closed also. Please listen to WZBG radio (97.3 FM) or tune in to TV stations WFSB and WVIT for all weather related delays and cancelations. . Cancellations and delays will also be posted on our website and through Remind. If you are a subscriber to our website "blog", you will receive notification of the new post.

LABEL CLOTHING

Now that cold weather has arrived, it is important that you LABEL your child's clothing! This Includes: Jackets, hats, mittens, boots, and backpacks. Children are not always aware of what their clothing looks like. It is very easy with multiple children in a class to get confused!

OUTDOOR PLAY

Cold weather has arrived! Please remember that we will go outside as weather permits. If the weather is 32 degrees or warmer (including wind chill) we will go out. Be sure to send your child in a WARM jacket, and don't forget to pack the mittens and hat! Boots are also recommended. If snow is on the ground then don't forget the snow pants! Please be sure to label all items of clothing with your child's name!

If girls come to school in a dress, be sure they wear warm leggings or tights!

REGISTRATION

Hilltop Registration for the 2018-2019 school year begins in December! Church members and current Hilltop families are able to register starting right away. Please be sure to register your child before January 20th when registration will open to the public. <u>Visitors to the Open House will have an opportunity for early enrollment.</u> **Spaces are filled on a first come, first served basis**.

The church office handles all registrations. Registrations are held during regular church office hours, Mon.-Fri. 9:00 a.m.-4:00 p.m. Registrations are NOT AFFECTED BY THE SCHOOL'S DELAYS OR CLOSINGS DUE TO WEATHER. If it is affected by weather, it will be announced through WFSB and WVIT as "St. Pauls" not "Hilltop Christian Early Learning Center". A confirmation letter will come to you when the form has been processed.

CURRENT SCHOOL YEAR ENROLLMENT

Hilltop continues to accept registrations for the current year. We still have spaces in all of our classes. If know someone with a 2, 3 or 4 year old who is not enrolled in a program, please refer them to us! Every child is entitled to a preschool experience to lay the groundwork for their school age years!

Also, Monday and Wednesday 3 year olds can add Fridays to their schedule, and Monday, Wednesday, Friday or Tuesday and Thursday 4 year olds can consider expanding the amount of days at school to 5 days a week. CURRICULUM

This year we have started using the Creative Curriculum ® from Teaching Strategies® to support our curriculum planning. Creative Curriculum® provides researched based curriculum resources for teachers of young children, yet still honors the teacher's creativity in implementing it. It guides the teachers to plan topics of study in depth and gives great guidance how to dig deeper into each study.

We began the year with the "Beginning of the School Year" resources, followed by the study of "Trees". When we return from our December break, the classrooms will begin a new study on "Clothes"! The teachers will guide the children as they study the features of clothes, how to take care of clothes, how clothes are made, how cloth is made, where we get our clothes, what special clothes are needed for work, and other special clothes. Your child's teachers will invite you to participate in a few ways, so be on the lookout for those opportunities!

During the month of December, the part time private pay classes will be focused on the birth of Jesus, his earthly parents and the other people that were around at the time of his birth. Meanwhile, in the School Readiness class, they will be sharing their family traditions and celebrations.
